**Georgia Department of Labor to conduct legislative update Thursday  
for employers in the Covington area**

**ATLANTA** – The Georgia Department of Labor’s (GDOL) Covington Area Employer Committee and the Covington Career Center will co-host a seminar on laws passed this year by the Georgia General Assembly. The focus will be on laws that are of primary interest to employers, including HB 87, the *Immigration Reform and Enforcement Act of 2011*.
