The Kings Bay Employer Committee, in partnership with the Georgia Department of Labor – Kings Bay Career Center, Camden County High School Youth Apprenticeship and Work-Based Learning Programs, Navy Fleet and Family Support Center, Camden Chamber of Commerce, Telamon Corporation, Privett-Bennett and Associates, Inc. and Coastal Georgia Community College – Camden Center are again this year sponsoring 13th Annual Youth Job Fair 2008 to be held Thursday, March 20 from 4:00 p.m. – 6:30 p.m. at the Camden County High School Cafeteria. Employers and educational vendors are invited to participate in this event at no cost. Over 300 job seekers attended Youth Job Fair 2007 and many employers were represented. Numerous job seekers were matched with employment opportunities due to the job fair. The job fair targets youth who are ages 15 - 22 though no one seeking an employment opportunity is denied admittance to the job fair.

The success of this annual job fair can be attributed to two factors: student involvement and community support. Each year, a committee of students assists with the planning, coordination and implementation of the job fair. The students utilize their leadership skills to market the event, coordinate logistics and register employers and jobseekers. The annual success of Youth Job Fair is dependent on the support of the area's employers. Companies are requested to send a representative to participate in the job fair and discuss employment opportunities with job seekers. Additionally, companies may show their support by making a monetary or in-kind contribution. Event sponsors request your assistance to provide food and beverage items, paper products, decorations, t-shirts for the student committee and door prizes. All monetary donations collected will go towards job fair expenses.
